

OVERVIEW	Chateau Ste. Michelle pioneered vinifera grape growing in Washington state and has been producing classic European varietal wines since 1967. The winery combines an ongoing dedication to research with a commitment to classic winemaking traditions. It is best known for its award-winning Riesling, Chardonnay, Merlot and Cabernet Sauvignon.		
OWNERSHIP	Wholly-owned subsidiary of Ste. Michelle Wine Estates, Woodinville, Washington.		
VINEYARDS	Chateau Ste. Michelle owns 3,500 acres of vineyards in the Columbia Valley. Its best known vineyards include Canoe Ridge Estate and Cold Creek.		
WINERY LOCATION	Chateau Ste. Michelle's white wines are fermented and aged in Woodinville, 15 miles northeast of Seattle. The winery is open to the public for tours and tasting from 10 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. daily. Chateau Ste. Michelle's red wines are made at Chateau Ste. Michelle Canoe Ridge Estate Winery in eastern Washington, 15 miles west of Paterson on the Columbia River.
